AFRICA BUILD (www.africabuild.eu) is a Coordination and Support Action aiming to improve Health Research and Education in Africa, through Information and Communication Technologies. The project, funded by the European Commission, gathers partners from Europe and Africa: Universidad Politécnica de Madrid (Spain), Ministry of Communications & Information Technology (Egypt) Université de Bamako (Mali), Université de Genève (Switzerland), Institute of Tropical Medicine (Belgium), World Health Organization (Switzerland), Université de Yaounde I (FMSB) and University of Ghana (Ghana).

From a conceptual perspective AFRICA BUILD, in its three years of duration, aims to provide scientific, technological and financial support for developing centers of excellence in health education and research in Africa. With these conferences AFRICA BUILD aims to increase interest in these topics, attract various stakeholders and share knowledge among them.
